


PRINCIPAL MESSAGE:


VISION





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
STRATERGIC HIGHLIGHTS

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With a great pleasure, I present in nutshell the highlights of the academic year 2020-2021:


RE-OPENING:

EXAMINATIONS:


Periodical Assessments and evaluations are conducted for the students and their progress is informed to the parents on an ongoing basis.








The school has always been keen in taking initiative to get the best in sports arena. Master Abbas won the gold medal representing the school.



It has a computer lab, science lab, a library, and well ventilated, spacious classrooms with a big playground for physical activities.

Long lockdown and pandemic disturbed our plans. Inspite of all hurdles we have completed the academicyear from July'20 to April'21.

In the month of February'21 the Government of Telangana has given the permission for physical classes for 6th to 10th Students. At that time precautions taken both inside and outside the classrooms to prevent the spread of Covid-19 We arranged one person (Mr. Ali Abbas) from GHMC Dept. He sanitized the whole building, classrooms, washrooms, labs, playground etc. We followed the protocols of Covid-19 and encouraged students not to gather and socialized in big groups during lunch and while leaving the schoolground.





In that duration we assigned projects and all necessary tests and exams were held for classes IX & X asper the government schedule, papers evaluated, donor reports prepared from classes I to IX and even Parent's Teacher's meeting were conducted.

Telangana Government has announced to shut all educational institutions from March 24^{th} 2021 due to rising number of covid-19 cases and postponed all exams once again we continued online classes from classes VI to X till April 30^{th} 2021.

The Class X examination has cancelled due to nationwide surge in covid19 cases, promoted the students on the basis of internal marks given by the school. 23 students from our school passed the exam. Our toppers are Butool Fatima, Syed Kaunain Begum, and Zainab Banu.

Academic year 2020-21 was a total chaos. It's unfortunate that no other sector has been as severely affected as the education sector. And parents were not in a position to admit their children in School asthey did not have money to pay meagre admission amount & monthly fees.

Wages they earned was insufficient for basic necessities. GOVERNMENT SUPPORT TO TEACHERS:

Pandemic is a hard lesson for private school teachers. With the closure of educational institutions in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic teaching and non-teaching staff of many Private Schools are living a handto mouth existence.

Hence, the Government of Telangana has decided to help private school teachers and helping them from the month of April'21 by giving Rs. 2,000 Per month and 25 KG.s of Rice. 50% teachers of our branch are benefiting with this scheme.






Mrs. Qaim Unissa Urdu Faculty has donated four ceiling fans and eight LED Bulbs for our new Block.
