



We pray for his magferat and May Allah (Swt) reward him the highest Place in Jannah by tufail of Chaarda Masoomeen (As). Ameen.


EXECUTIVES



I also thank my fellow board members for their invaluable support in guiding the organization and enabling another year of growth.




The students could never afford the tablets on their own. A glitter has come on their faces. They have started taking care of the tablets and their overall behavior has improved.


