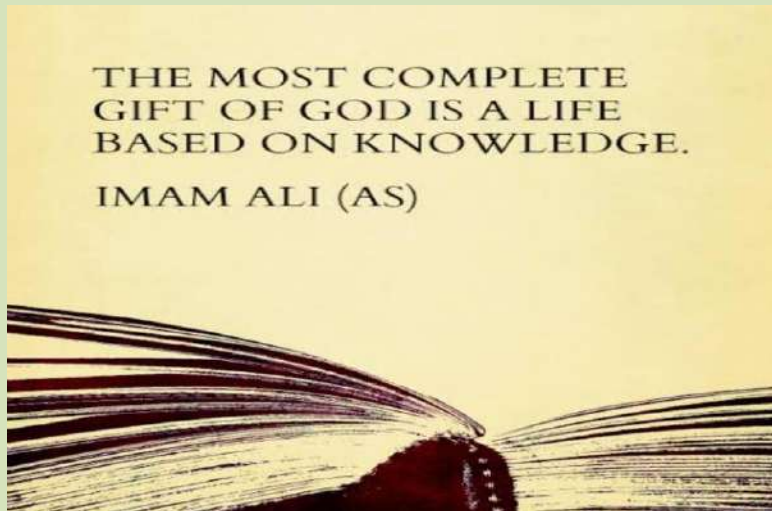

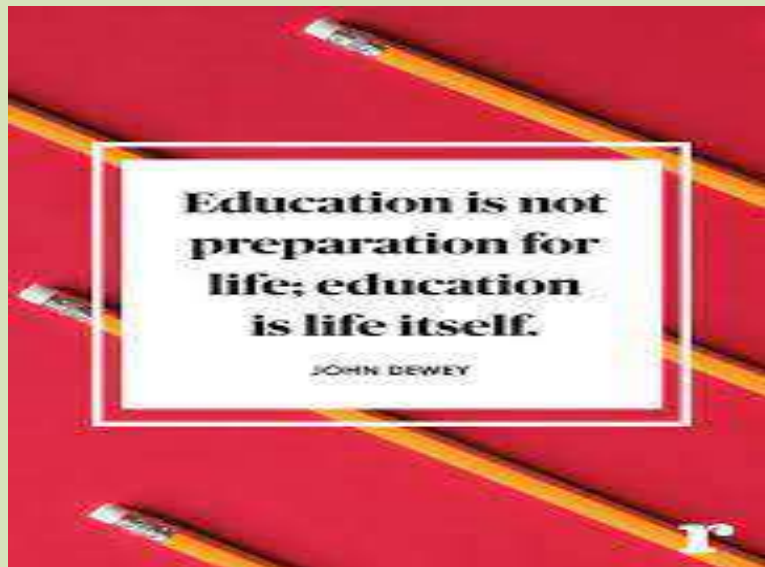

On 1st April 2022, our high school students along with our staff went to the Silent Wald Resort for the annual excursion.





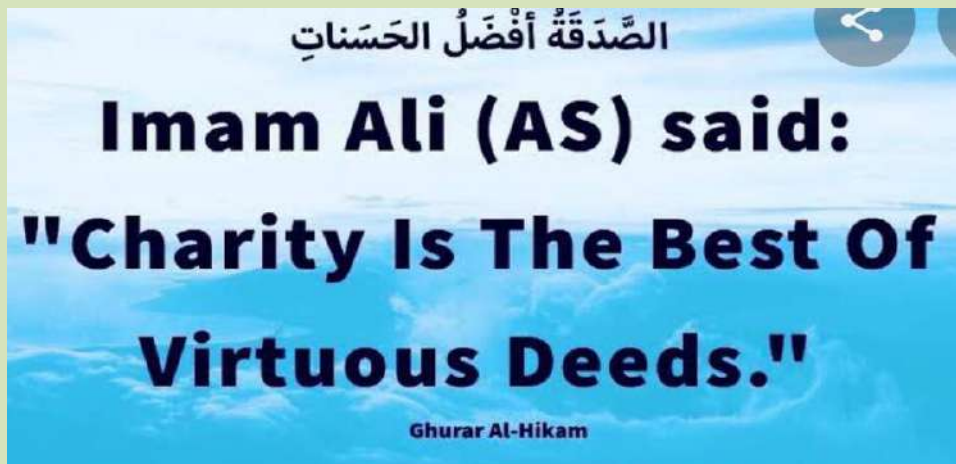

Following are the contribution to the needy & poor parents.

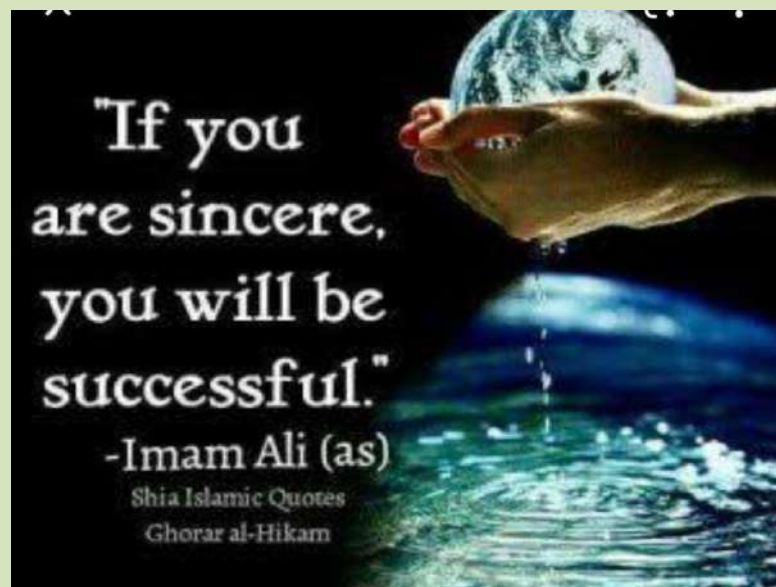

Worksheets are given to consolidate learning and stimulate independent thinking and effort is made especially in the primary classes. Careful consideration is given to field trips also.

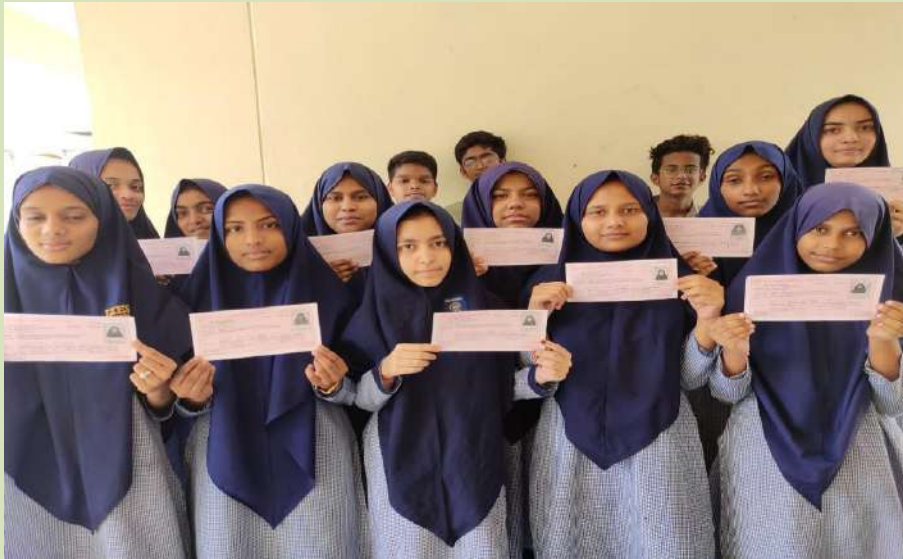
- For upper primary and high school we had assigned activities, book reviews, projects etc throughout the academic year as it increases the creativity, self writing & self confidence of the students.

Life never ends after an examination, but surely its results have long lasting positive impact on students and other stakeholders.

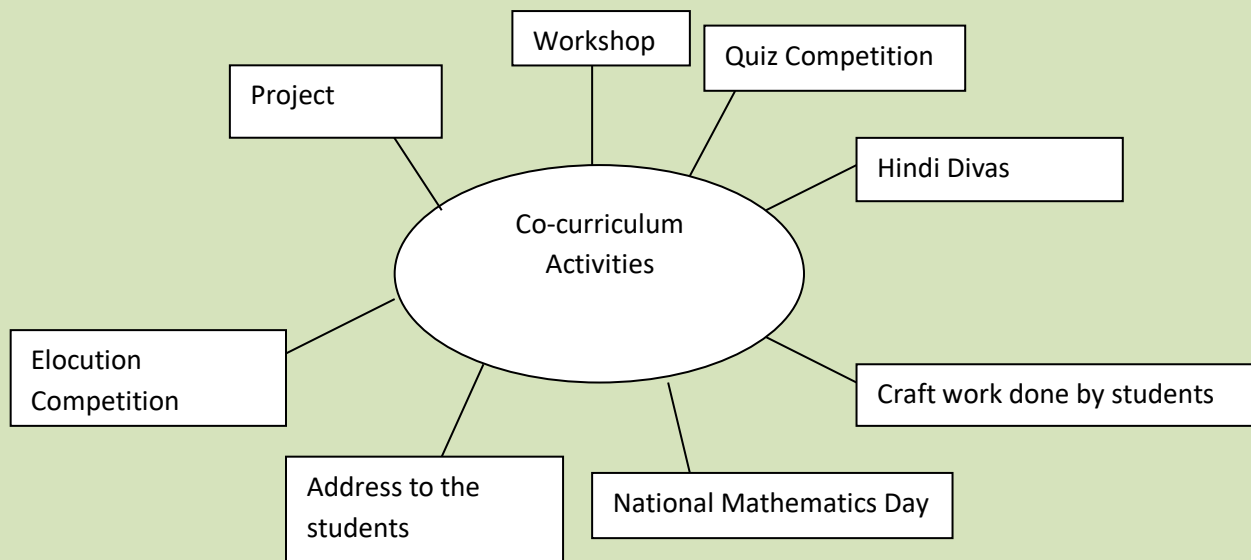

➤ **Hindi Divas:**

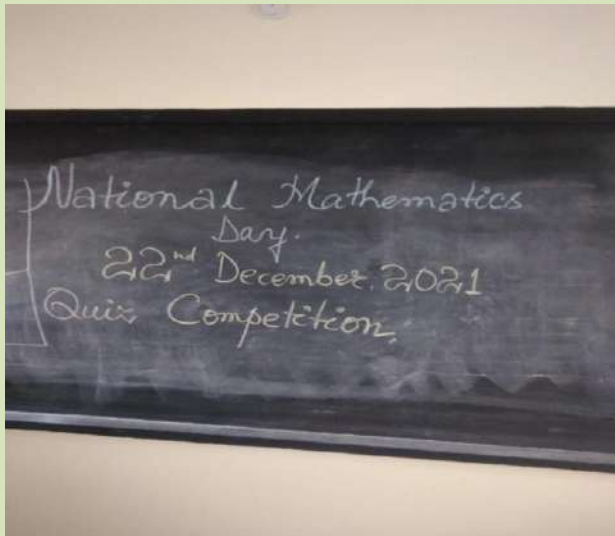

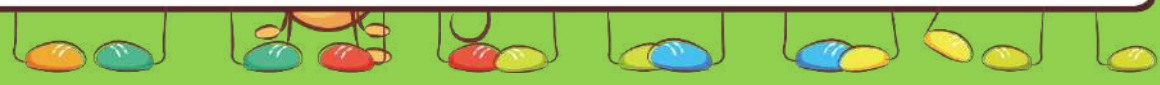

INTRODUCTION



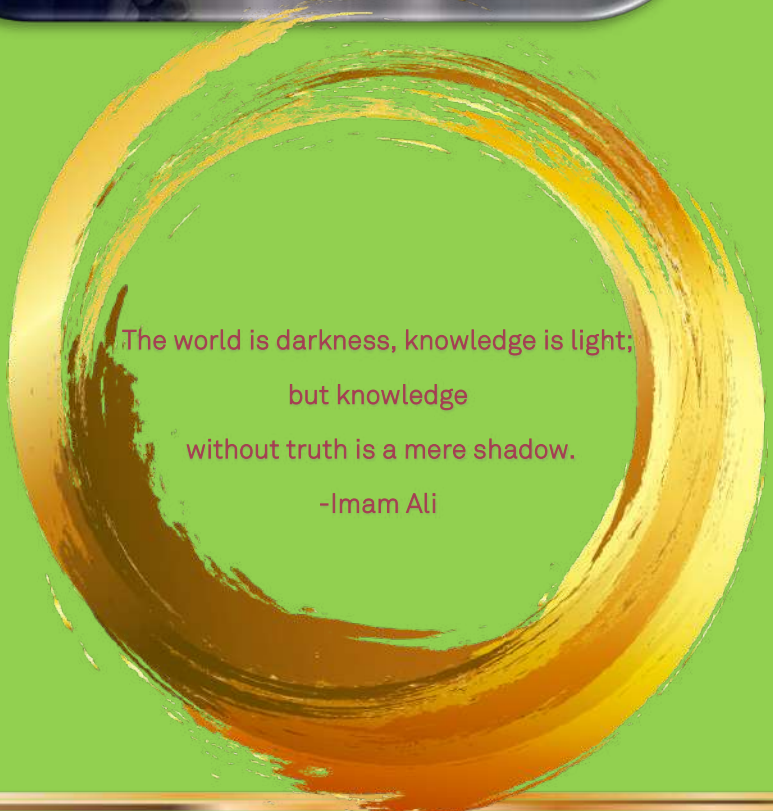
In the session 2021-22 the total strength of the school from LKG to Class X were 394 students, 17 teaching staff, & 4 Non-teaching staff members.

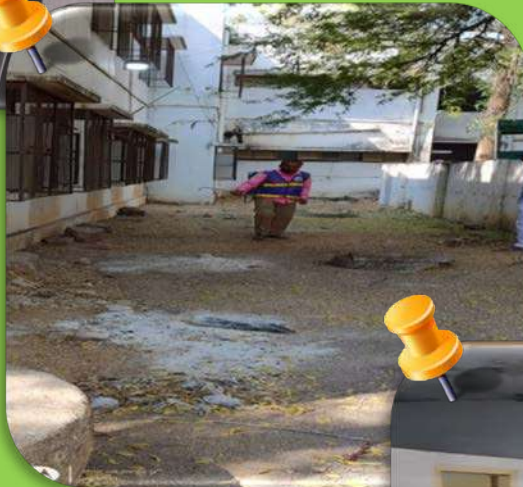

Educational topic was “Hyderabad city security council Cyber Smart online training” for children was done on 3rd &4th sept 2021 and digital certificates were issued.



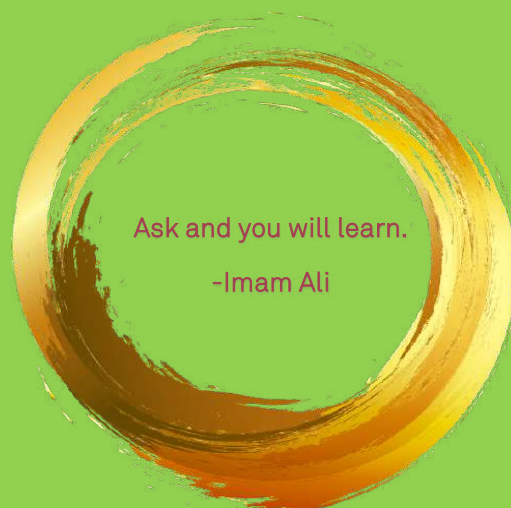

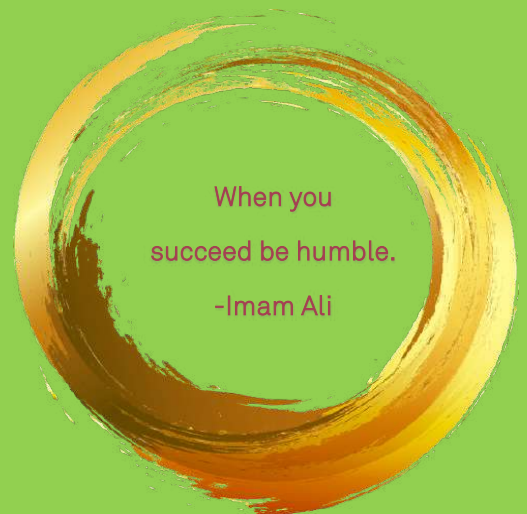
