
President





With our value-based approach, we continue to be an institution which focuses on its commitment to long-term and consistent value creation for all the stakeholders. Our future is shaped by how we envision it today and how we work towards ultimately molding it.

Optimism: Finding Infinite Hope Amidst Finite Disappointments

It was the pandemic that jolted the world in 2020 and 2021, this year, it was the compounding impact of geopolitical tension and rampaging cost inflation that has had a tumbling effect on everything from the economy to people's income and wellbeing to supply chain disruptions, nothing has been left unaffected. The cost of living has gone up substantially. The pandemic has scared away many

from the teaching profession, into other professions. Many educational institutions have closed down.

Yet, let us not forget, as Hazrat Ali (AS) said,

"Do not give up hope if the answer to your request is slow in coming, for surely what you receive depends on the strength of your request."

I found this inspiring for another reason. To me, if there is one phrase that can sum up the over 3 decade's history of your institution, it is this: finding infinite hope without being daunted by finite disappointments. What have we not seen in these 3 plus decades? Wars, floods, famines, world-altering pandemic, economic ups and downs. All the above events have adversely affected our donor community. Yet we have not only survived but thrived as an institution, serving the poorest of poor of the community... Similarly, this great institution has seen many ups and downs, many tough moments and yet has always come out stronger and delivered the right quality of service to all its stakeholders.

We thus know a thing or two about the anatomy of infinite hope. And that is the message I bring to you today, that things may be tough, but we will always stay optimistic. But here's another thing we have learned:

And so, in the true tradition of IMAM E ZAMANA MISSION, I stand here before you not to glorify our past, but to tell you of how we plan to shape and change our future for the better. But before that, let me start with what dominated our world in the recent past: COVID. We had our last AGM when the second, the most devastating COVID wave, hadn't left our shores yet. Since then, we have had more, thankfully not so devastating, waves. To ensure the health and safety of our staff, workers, and students, we implemented the adequate level of health, sanitation, and safety standards as well as vaccination support across all our schools and offices.

The journey to realizing our collective potential

It comes from our three fundamental values-caring, teamwork, and continuous improvement. We must also remember that the lingering grey skies of the pandemic are exacerbated by geopolitical tensions, unprecedented inflation, supply chain disruption, slower economic growth, and currency devaluation. But amidst that, we stay confident, optimistic and resolute. Let me share the financial results now. Our full year numbers. Gross receipt for the financial year 2021-22 stood at ₹360lakhs against ₹280lakhs of the previous year.

Our education division disbursed ₹94,00,000/-, Maali Imdad ₹23,00,000/- Ramzan Distribution ₹32,00,000/- Health ₹1,50,000/-, Qaza Namaz & Roza and Recitation of Holy Quran ₹7,00,000/-.

While we expect the trend to improve in the coming year. We remain cautiously optimistic for the year with the significant challenge of input cost in the form of increases in salaries due to inflation that will have to be managed optimally. Through the year, we were able to face all challenges because we had the trust of our donors and it is this trust that has helped IMAM E ZAMANA MISSION remain in the forefront.

I thank The World Federation of Khoja Shia Ishna E Ashri Muslim Community of United Kingdom, Beta Charitable Trust of United Kingdom, Sajjadiyya Trust of Canada, Saheb e Asr Mission of USA, Islamic Education Centre, Houston, USA, Baquri family of USA, Mrs & Dr. Syed Ali Naqi of Houston and other donors totaling in all 212 for having given large sums of money to IZM for its various projects.

I request the donors community to contribute more and more towards upliftment of the under privileged. The donors support is all important, if things at the ground level have to change.

I emphasize upon the continuity of work and involvement of more and more like minded and well meaning people as donors and workers to expand the footprint of the activities of the organization, in shia community of Hyderabad.

We take our responsibility to educate the upcoming youth seriously. Positive impact on the lives of people is a priority for this institution. All of this is captured in our strategy, a strategy to deliver Sustainability and Social impact.

Scholarship programs that offer financial support to meritorious and deserving candidates with scholarships and mentorship in the fields of Primary Education, Higher Education, Sports and Community betterment. So far 52 students have been awarded scholarships for Higher Education (College and Professional) for a total of ₹5,50,500/- and 100% of scholars come from families having an income of less than Rupees One lakh per annum. We have started a Saathi Help Desk in association with SAFA society at IZM SCHOOL, Maula Ali, to help the poor community members avail benefits under various government schemes free of cost.

THE FUTURE WILL BE FOR THOSE WHO WILL BE ABLE TO IMAGINE, DESIGN AND BUILD IT.

The pandemic has prevented us from showing our capacity and capabilities for the past two years. Alhamdulillah, this ongoing academic year 2022-23, will be the first full year when an uninterrupted working will be possible. In anticipation of which TEAM IZM/IZES has got its full operations in place. All the four schools under its management and control have got adequate renovations. The computer labs have been refurbished, and all the four schools are on a hiring spree, to cater to the increase in the number of students seeking admissions. As a part of ongoing welfare measures IZM has distributed free note books of ITC CLASSMATE & SAATHI brand, Text books, good quality branded leather shoes and socks. Uniforms to all the students studying in all the 4 schools is proposed to be distributed.

As I look ahead, nonetheless, I remain more optimistic than ever. We are especially well-positioned to be the provider of choice with the set of capabilities that are most relevant to our stakeholders. The goal should be to amplify human potential.


