### **ACADEMIC PROGRAMS**

### **Welcome Program**

The New Academic year started on 12th June 2023 with a lot of enthusiasm and hopes to bring much needed change to raise the standard of education in our schools.

### **Academic Programs**

Many interventions were made in the academic year to bring about improvements in the learning abilities of our children. These are described below.

### School assembly

School assembly is conducted in the school yard everyday. Students are assigned class-wise responsibilities which encourage public speaking via performance of a 5-minute skit. The school assembly has become a valuable learning platform.







### **Academic Programs**

### Handwriting improvement sessions

20 minutes have been allocated daily for handwriting improvement. Students practice slant, alignment, and letter formation under the supervision of their class teacher every morning.

### **Newspaper Reading**

Using newspapers as a learning tool offers students a rich and multifaceted educational experience. We provide newspapers for every child twice a week and allocate 20 minutes in the morning for reading. This practice helps students to stay informed about current events, and fosters civic awareness and, critical thinking skills, which are crucial for their future as responsible citizens. Additionally, it enhances language proficiency and broadens their knowledge base across various subjects.

### Remediation

A remedial program syllabus has been designed to help students to overcome learning obstacles and achieve their full potential. It focuses on Urdu, English, and Math and incorporates activity-based student engagement. We have been closely monitoring the progress of the students who continue to struggle, by providing individualized academic support. We have introduced the Academic Intensive Care Unit (AICU) aimed at assisting children with significant academic gaps, determined via a Special Education Needs assessment.

### **Academic Programs**

### 10th Class After-School Academic Support

Due to significant academic gaps and learning challenges, additional after-school academic support for Class 10 has been provided since August. Furthermore, on Saturdays, an extra 4 hours of dedicated remedial support is available.

We have also implemented a study hours program because most students lack a suitable place to study at home, due to small living spaces or joint-family arrangements. After the support classes, students go home, refresh, and return in an hour to study at school for 4 hours (from 6 pm to 10 pm) under the supervision of additional part-time teachers who provide extra assistance in the evenings. Snacks are also served to these students






## Extracurricular Activities Teaching Learning Material Fair
















## Extracurricular Activities Science Fair

We have three counselors among our staff: one parttime and two full-time. They are here to assist students with their behavior and to address any non-academic concerns that they may have. Additionally, in August, we organized a special counseling session for parents, which was greatly appreciated and received positive feedback.

#### **House visits**

A dedicated team comprising Moulana Agha Munawer, Moulana Murtuza Naqvi, Mr. Humayun, and Mr. Alamdar conducted home visits. Their aim was to counsel parents, emphasizing the importance of supporting their children's studies and creating a conducive study environmentat home. These ensured diligent homework completion, school assignments, and regular punctuality among the students. More importantly these visits are also aimed at understanding the family situation and any provide help for any crises at home. Up until May 2024, 400 house visits have been completed.

#### Student record corrections:

The student record files were inconsistent, with many lacking essential primary information such as birth certificates and Aadhaar numbers. There were also issues with incorrect student names and parents' names. 50% of the student record files have been verified and corrected so far and work is still in progress.

### **Counseling Department**

The counseling department at IZM Yakutpura has various initiatives to introduced support students' educational, emotional, and mental well-being, while also guiding teachers and parents. Multiple sessions were held separately for mothers and fathers throughout the year. Mothers shared insights and tips, while the fathers' sessions highlighted the need for a community space for parenting discussions. Fathers were provided with advice to boost their confidence in parenting, and issues raised by mothers were shared to encourage a holistic approach.

The Yakutpura schools (Boys & Girls campuses) are now under full CCTV surveillance, with cameras installed in all classrooms, corridors, and the grounds. Maintaining student discipline, monitoring teaching activities, and preventing unforeseen incidents is of utmost importance.

### **Heavy Duty Printer**

We purchased a heavy-duty printer for printing worksheets, making work much easier for teachers, and significantly reducing the cost of printing these teaching materials

## OT (occupational therapy) Room

We conducted screenings from Nursery to Class 1 for learning difficulties and identified 48 children with severe issues that cannot be effectively handled by the class teacher, alone. These children require daily occupational therapy (OT). We promptly acquired the necessary equipment and initiated OT sessions with the assistance of trainers from the Endeavor section of Focus School. Our search for additional trainers at IZM is ongoing, and we need to expand our setup and acquire many more necessary items to establish a perfect OT room.





## **Summer Camp 2024**







IZM School Yakutpura organized the Summer Camp 2024 at its BHS and GHS campuses for the first time on a scale that required meticulous planning, mobilization of resources and well organized logistics. The Summer Camp started on 1st May 2024 and concluded on 24th May 2024 for all the children except for high school boys, which concluded on June 3 with the event of Jashn e Ibadat.

Qaza Namaz, Qaza Roza and Recitation of the Holy Quran is a source of financial help to those needy persons who are restricted to their homes and cannot take up employment outside to earn their livelihood and the Marhumeen will benefit from Isale Sawab.
