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Our initiative to re-enroll school dropouts has received a positive response, with over 76 students now enrolled. These students, who left school for various reasons, have been assessed based on their current academic level and grouped into homogeneous batches. This ensures tailored instruction, enabling faster progress and smoother reintegration into the mainstream education system. Qualified staff have been recruited to provide age-appropriate instruction. The goal is to accelerate academic progress and prepare these children for re-entry into regular schools.

Initially, we focused on addressing high dropout rates. Through engagement, we found that many students have high intellectual potential but faced obstacles like lack of interest in specific subjects, family disturbances, or unsuitable environments, hindering their education. Dropouts often face disdain in schools and at home, leading to potential involvement in anti-social activities. By understanding and addressing the reasons behind their educational discontinuation, we aim to provide these children with a pathway back to education.

Integrating these children into the mainstream school system is crucial for their future and societal well-being.

Our initiative's early success is a promising step towards achieving this goal.














































## MEDICAL CAMP
