- Focus on character-building, empathy, and values from Karbala.







# SPECIAL ASSEMBLY

- 🏏 Cricket Team: Reached the finals and emerged as the Runner-Up in the Under-17 category!




# DOCTOR'S DAY




# GRATITUDE DAY






# FIELD TRIP TO NASR SUPER MARKET

# CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES


