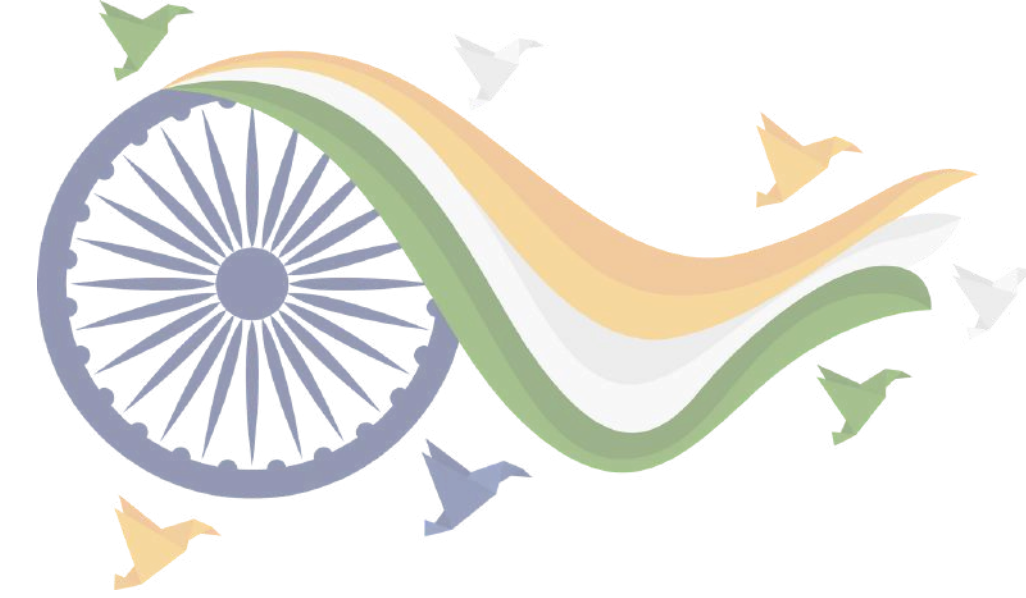

Birla Planetarium

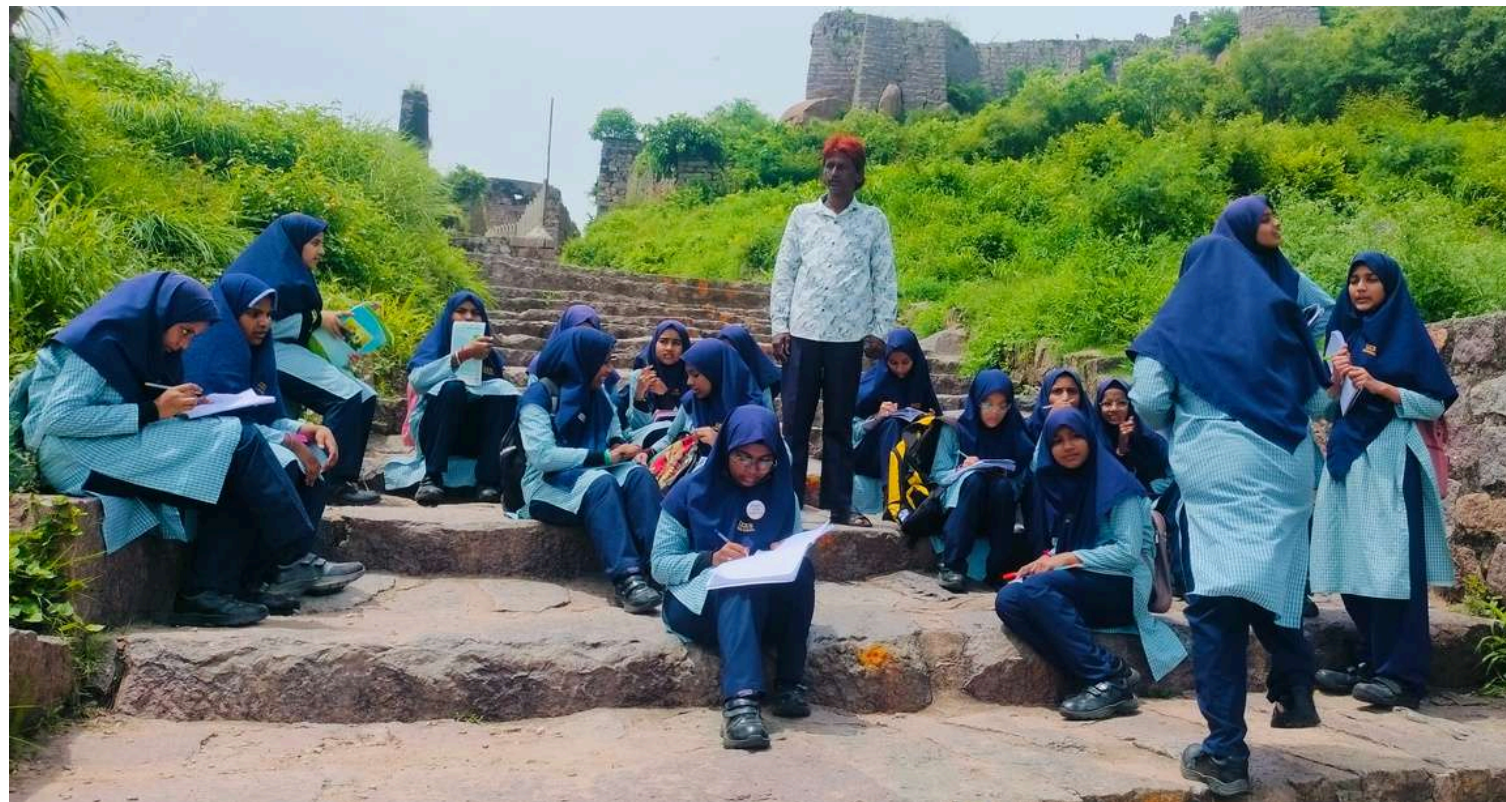

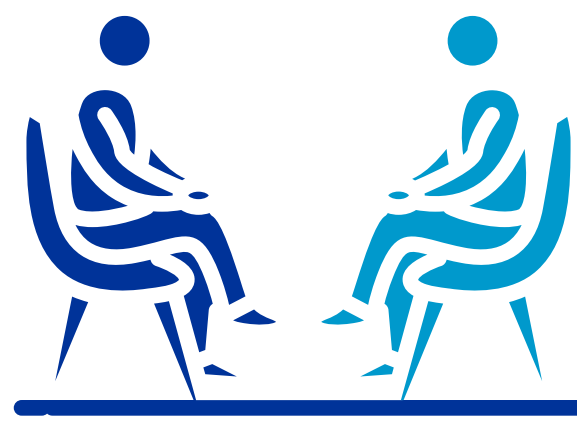


Deworming Day program
