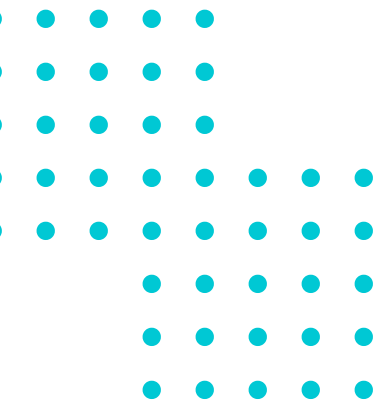
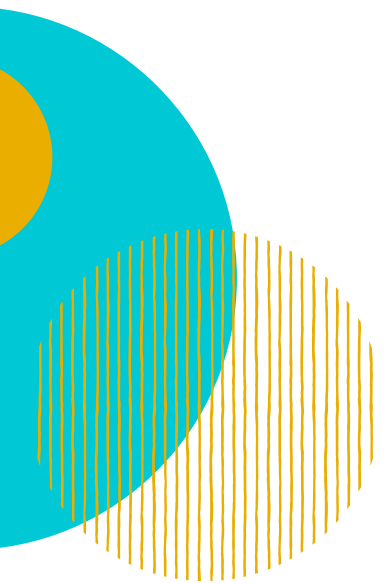


SESSION ON KIRDAR (CHARACTER

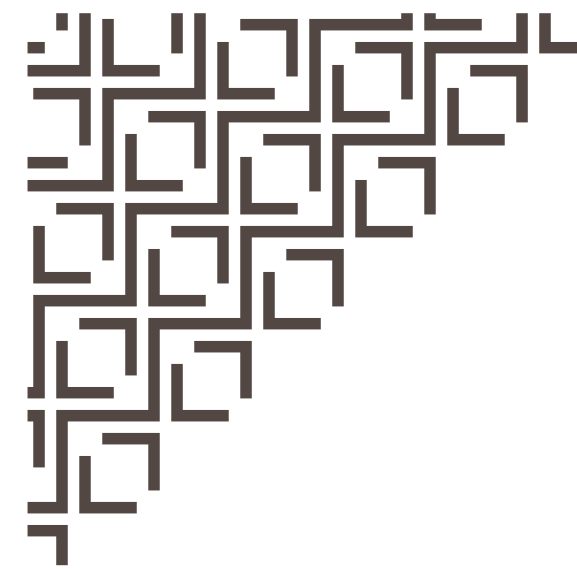
MOCK PARLIAMENT SESSION



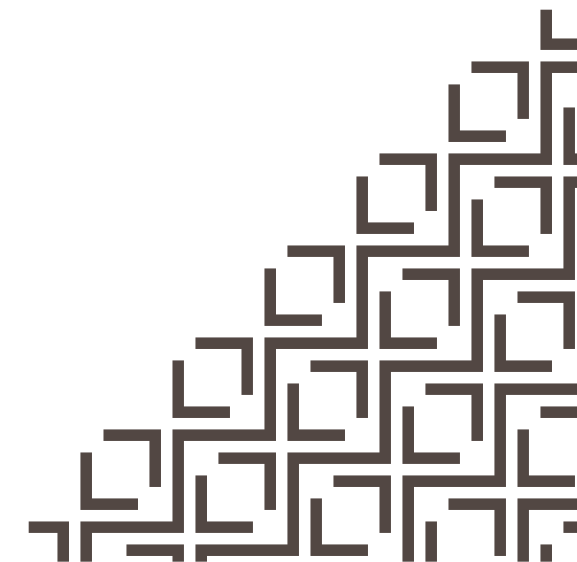

SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

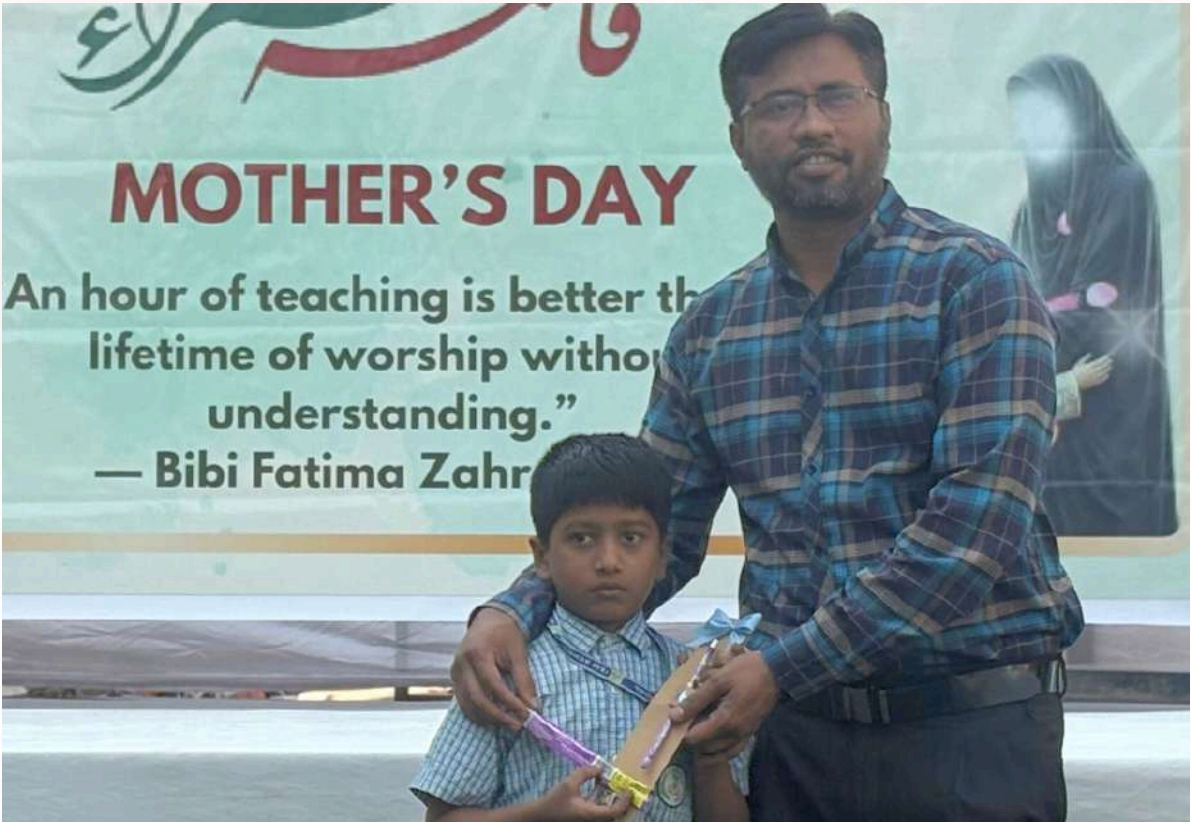

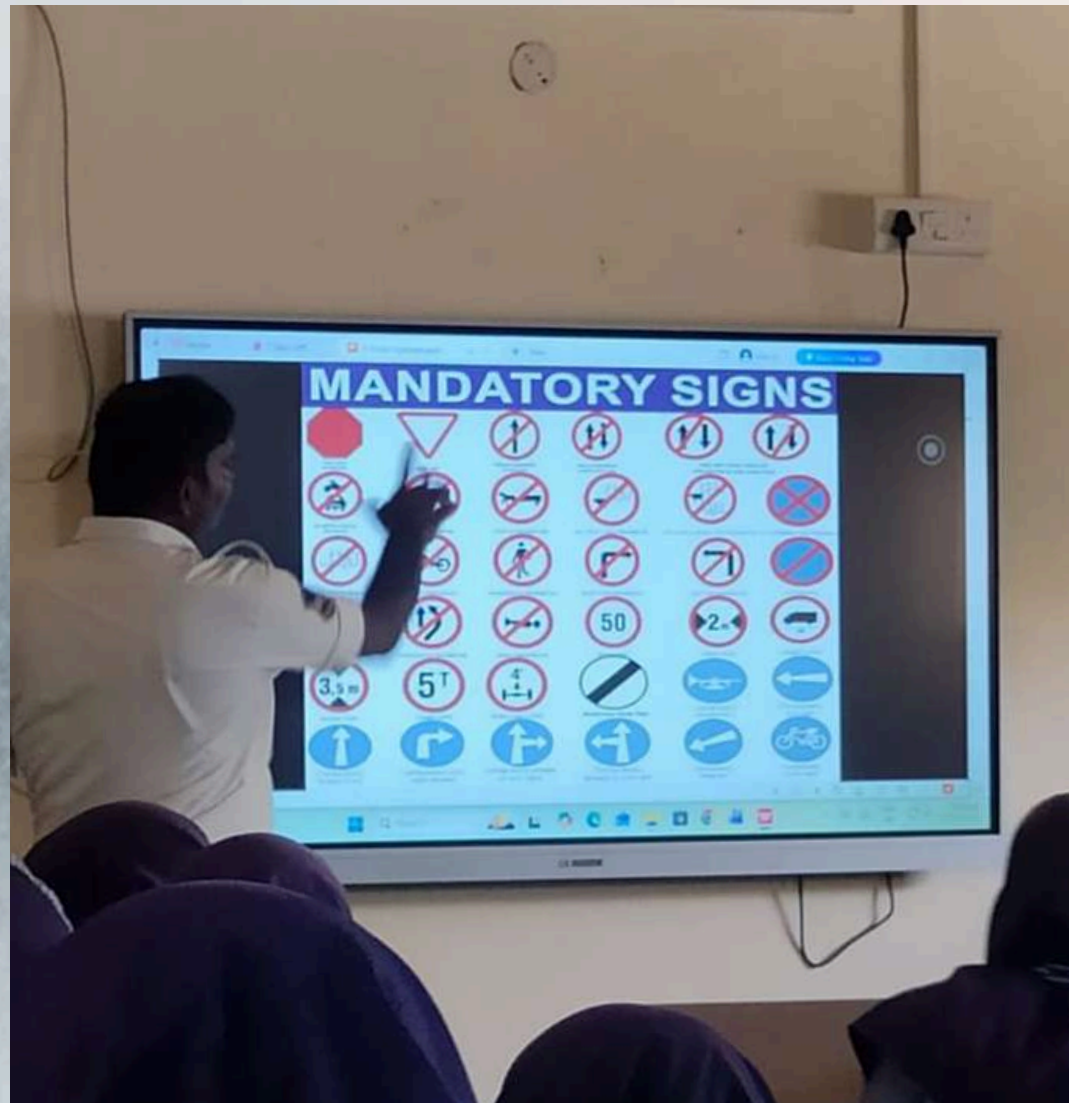

JASHAN-E-13TH RAJAB

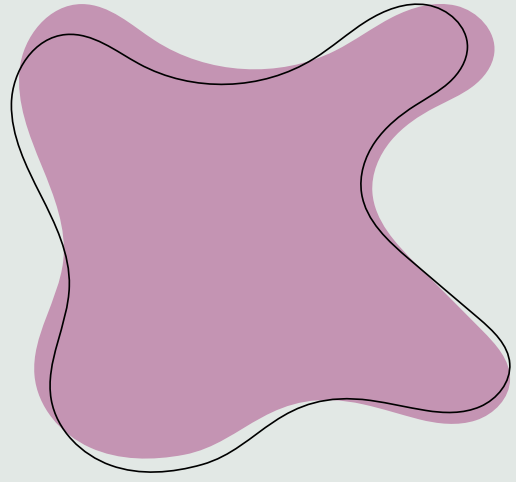
