## BAZM-E-MA'RIFAT

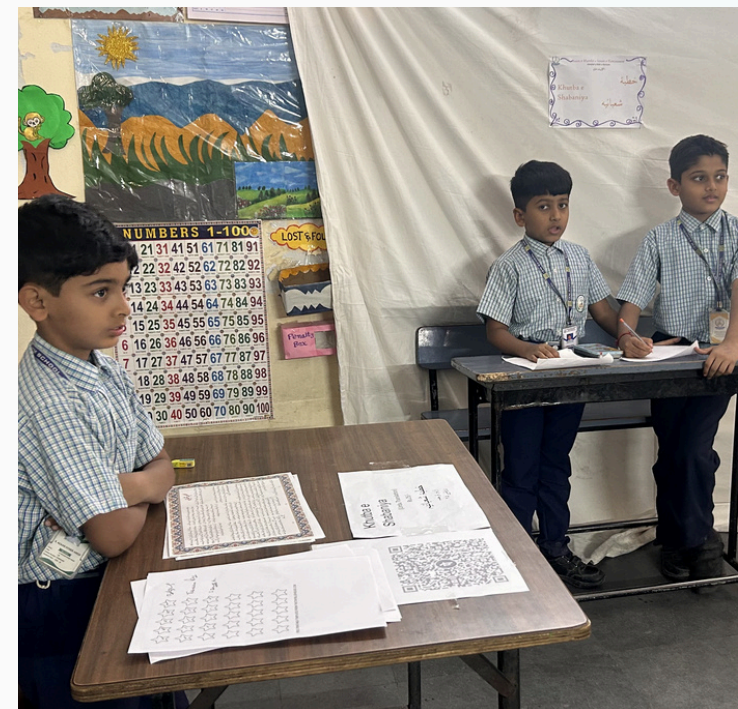

# SPECIAL ASSEMBLY

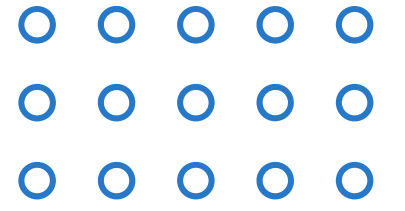
Special assemblies were organized to encourage moral, spiritual, and environmental awareness among students. These programs helped students understand important values and social responsibilities.
