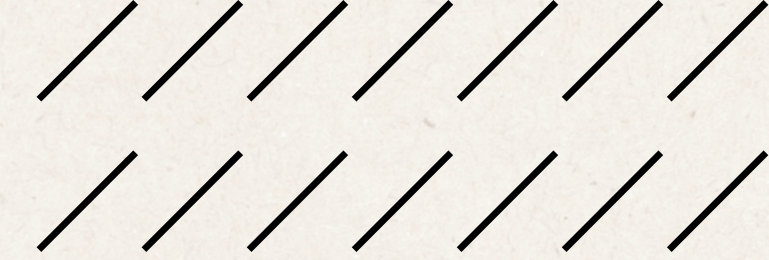

# REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

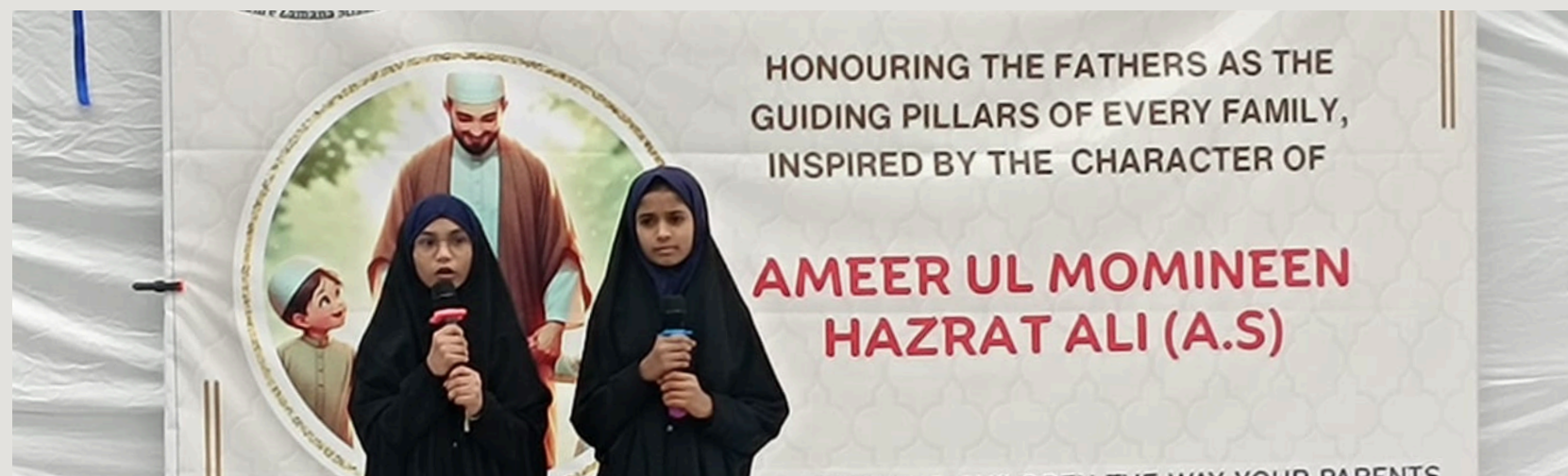

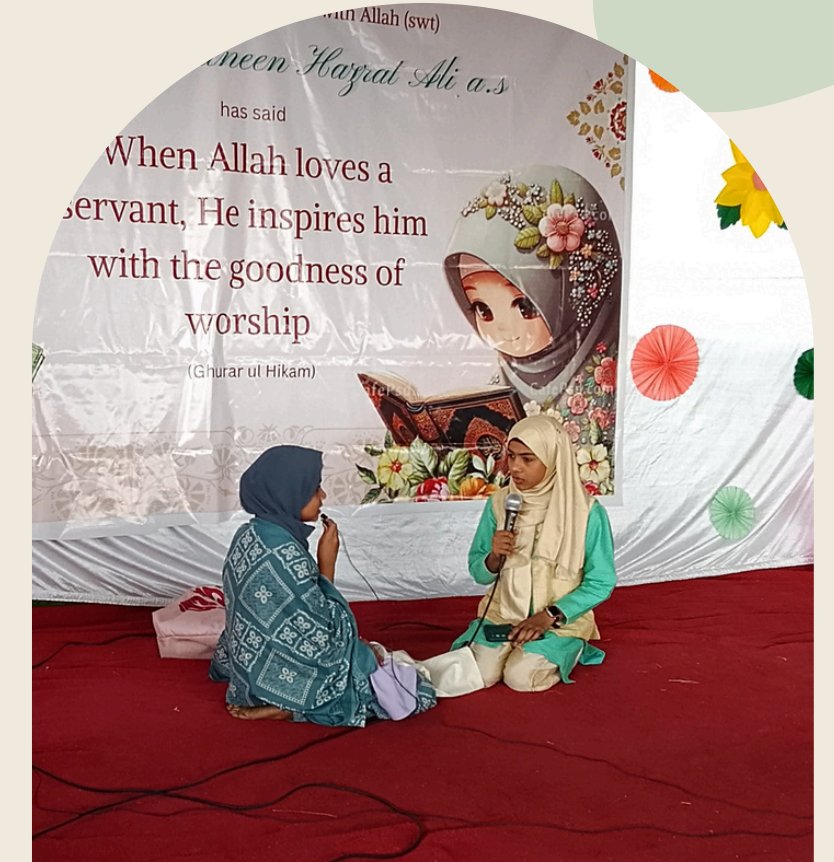




# FATHER'S DAY CELEBRATION
