# JASHN-E-MILAD UN NABI (SAWS)

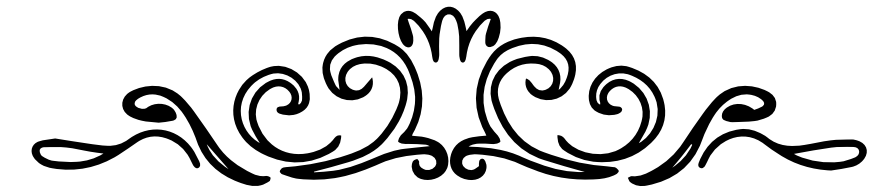

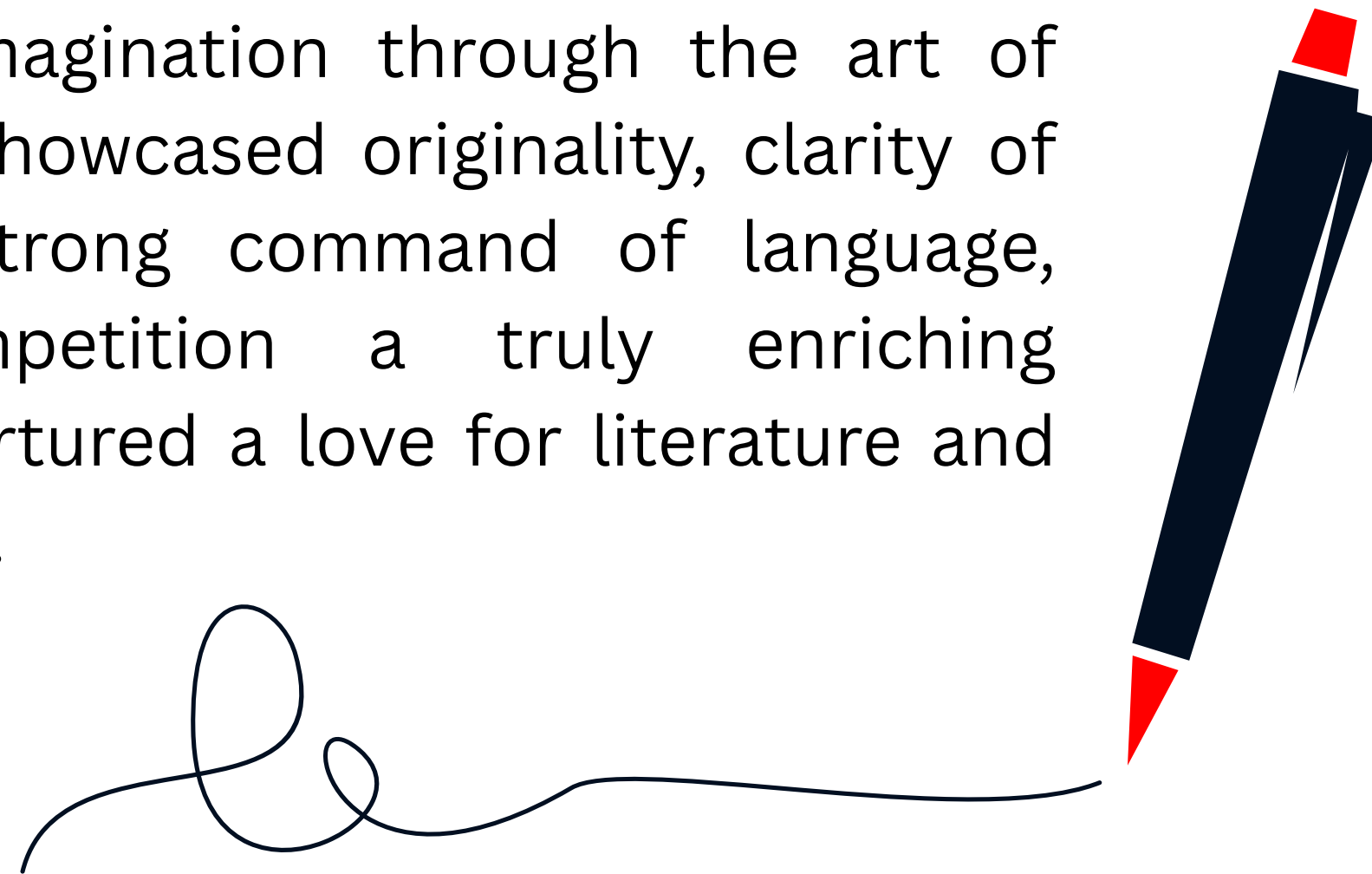

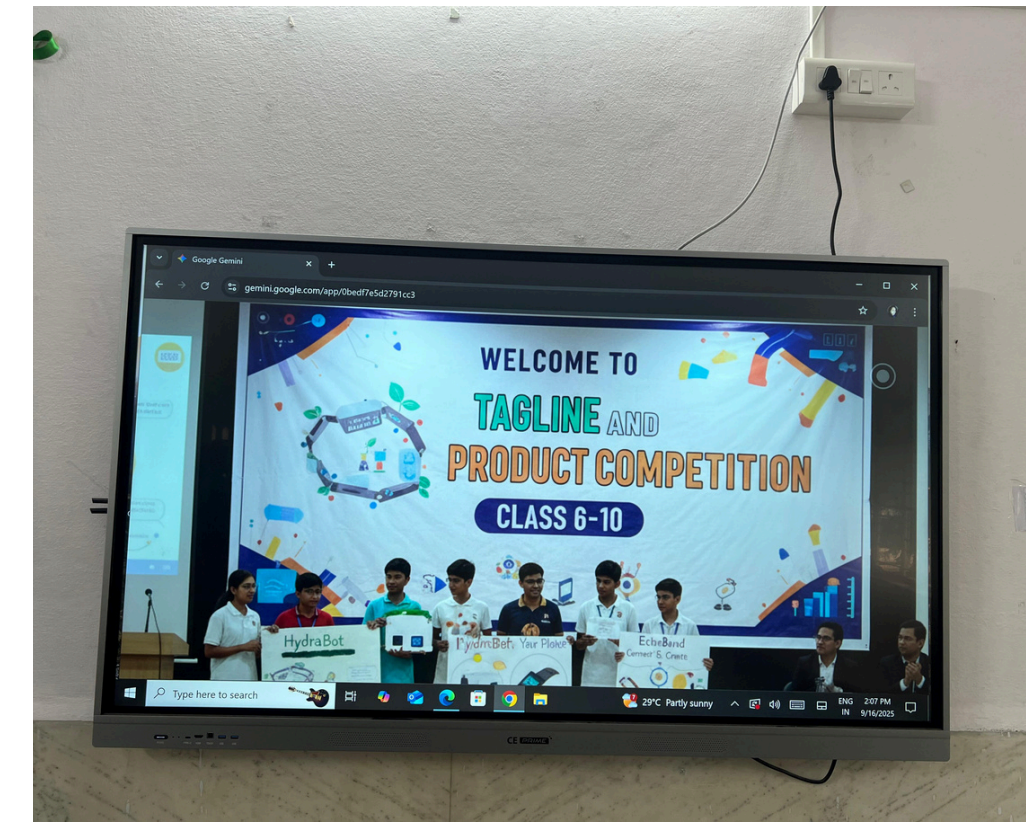
# ENGLISH ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

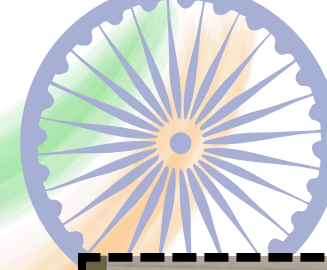
# TAGLINES AND PRODUCT COMPETITION

# EDUCATIONAL FIELD TRIPS

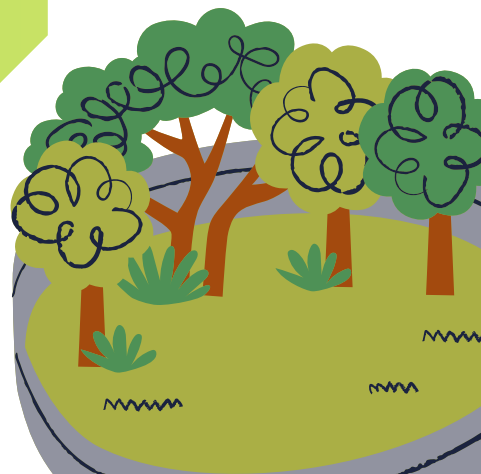

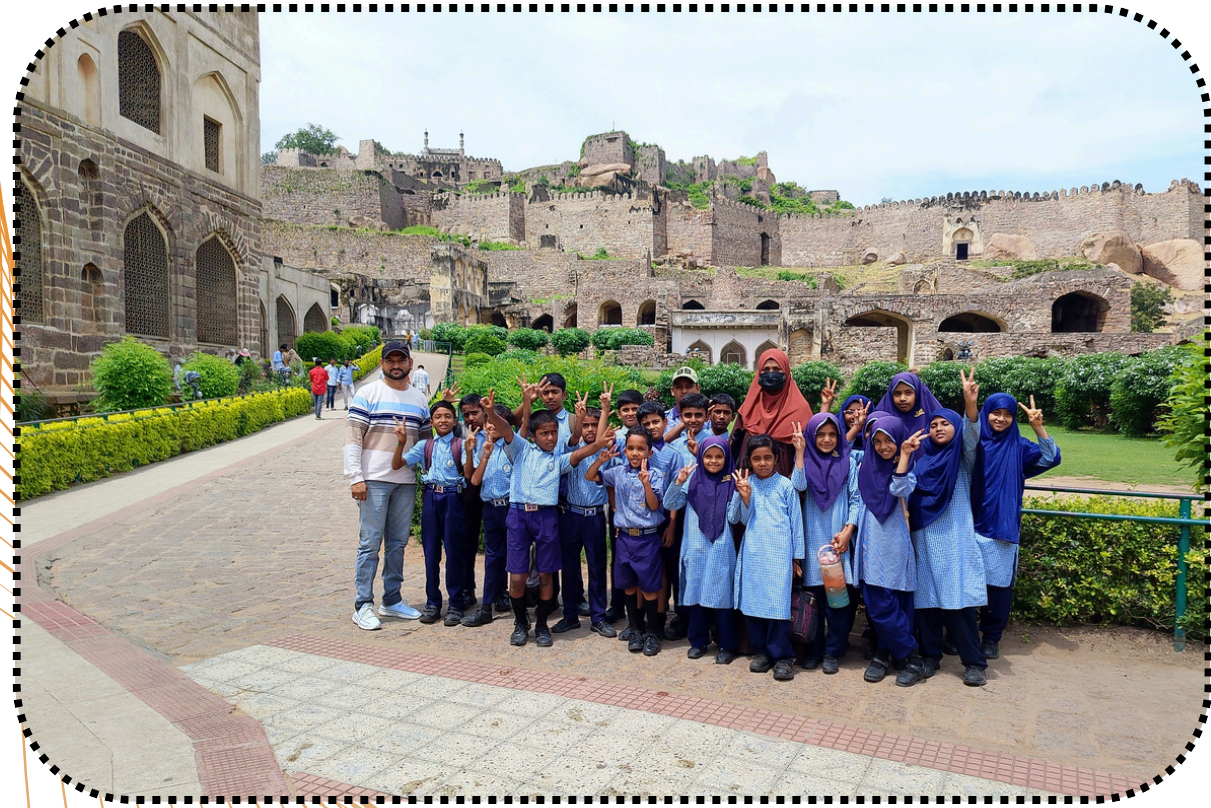


# GOLCONDA FORT
