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Expert Talks

An enlightening expert talk was conducted by Maulana Shahid Pradhan Sahab on the qualities of true lovers and those who await Imam-e-Zamana (a.t.f.s.), while also motivating students to prepare for competitive examinations. Students were encouraged to trust themselves, seek the blessings of Imam-e-Zamana (a.t.f.s.), and work diligently towards their goals. He also delivered an inspiring and thought-provoking session on the values of Karbala, leadership, justice, teamwork, and the importance of preparing students for future success. He stressed that success is not achieved individually but through teamwork, unity, and capable supporting leadership.



Majlis on the Martyrdom of Bibi Sakina (s.a.)

The Majlis focused on the importance of Taqwa, based on Surah 49:13. Taqwa was explained as protecting the nafs, fearing Allah, and living with the awareness that Allah is always watching us. Imam Ali (a.s.) described Taqwa as the shield of a believer. The Maulana shared a narration in which Janab Adam (a.s.) saw three beautiful faces representing Aql (wisdom), Mohabbat (love), and Haya (modesty). Three dark faces represented Arrogance, Hasad (jealousy), and Tama (greed), showing how the loss of wisdom, love, and modesty leads to negative traits.



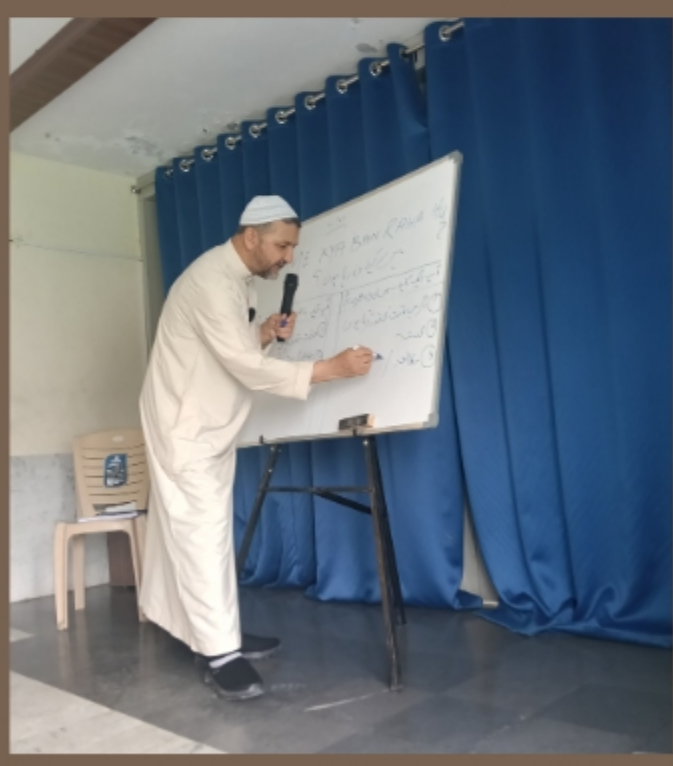
Motivational Talk

Green Day Celebration

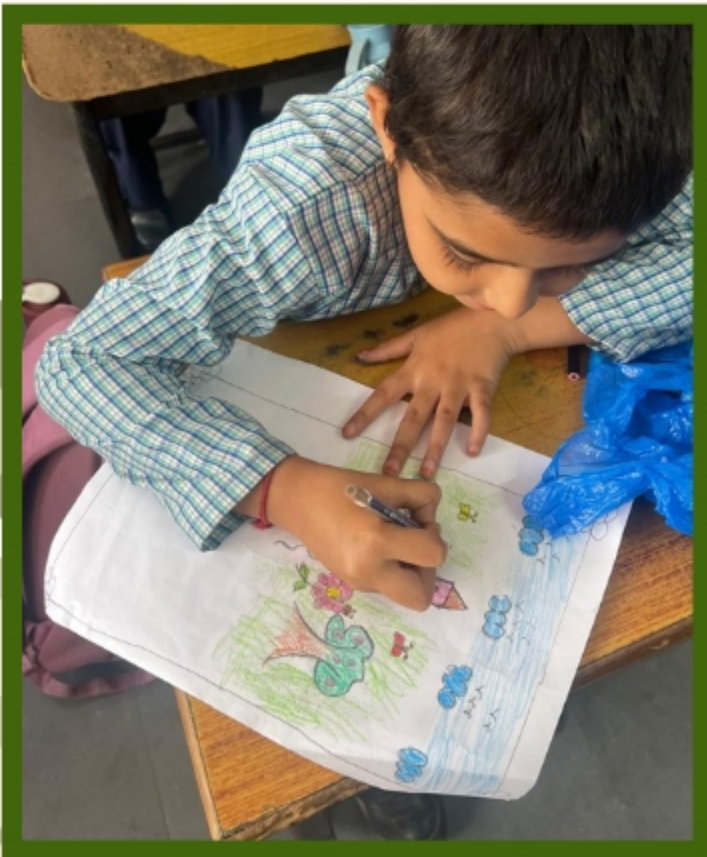

Van Mahotsav Day

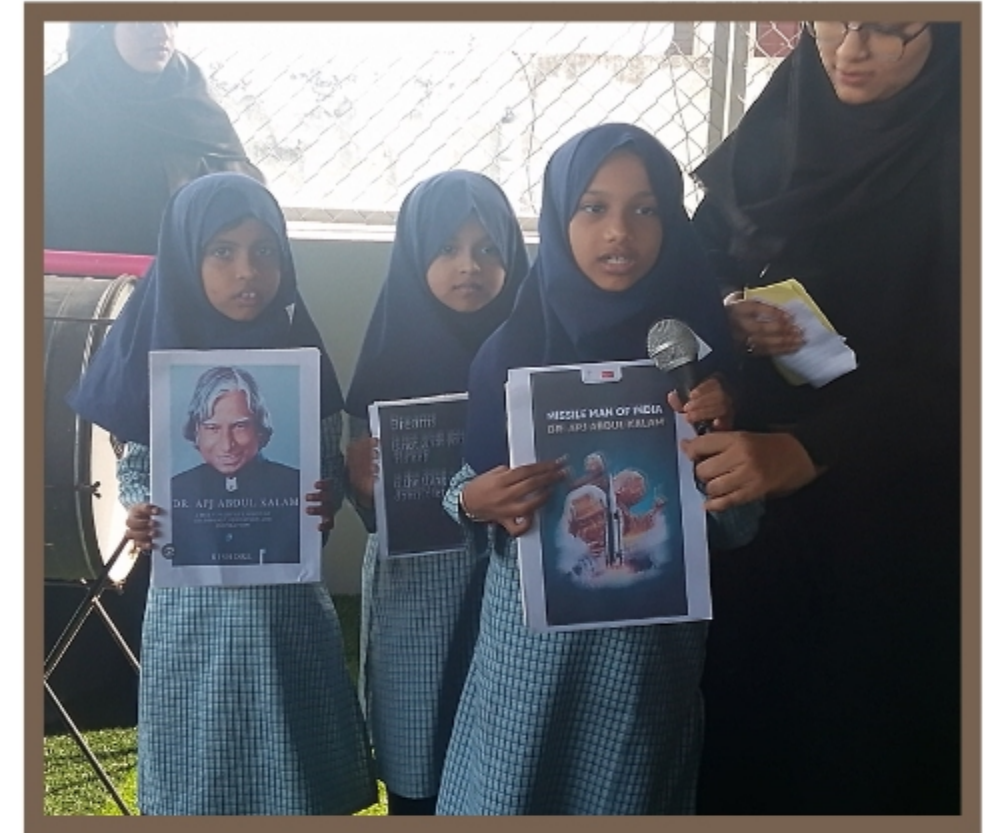
