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INDEPENDENCE DAY

MORNING ASSEMBLIES

The morning assemblies conducted by Class 4B, Class 6A, Bridge C2, and NIOS students included speeches, skits, quizzes, and presentations on hard work, positive habits, gratitude, responsibility, and Islamic values. 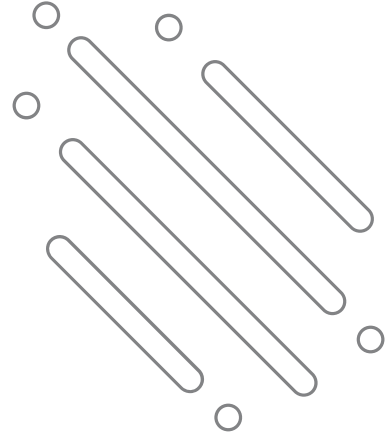


AYYAM-E-AZA

SHAHADAT OF IMAM HASAN AL-ASKARI (A.S)

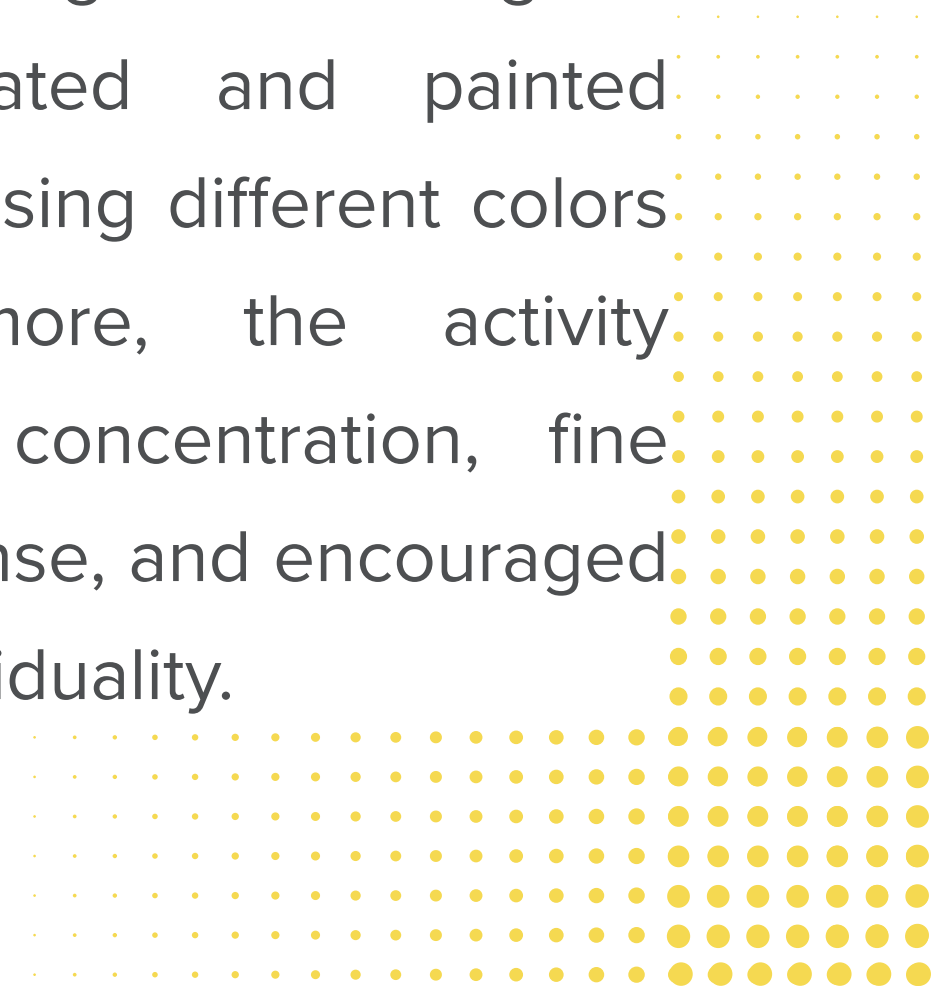

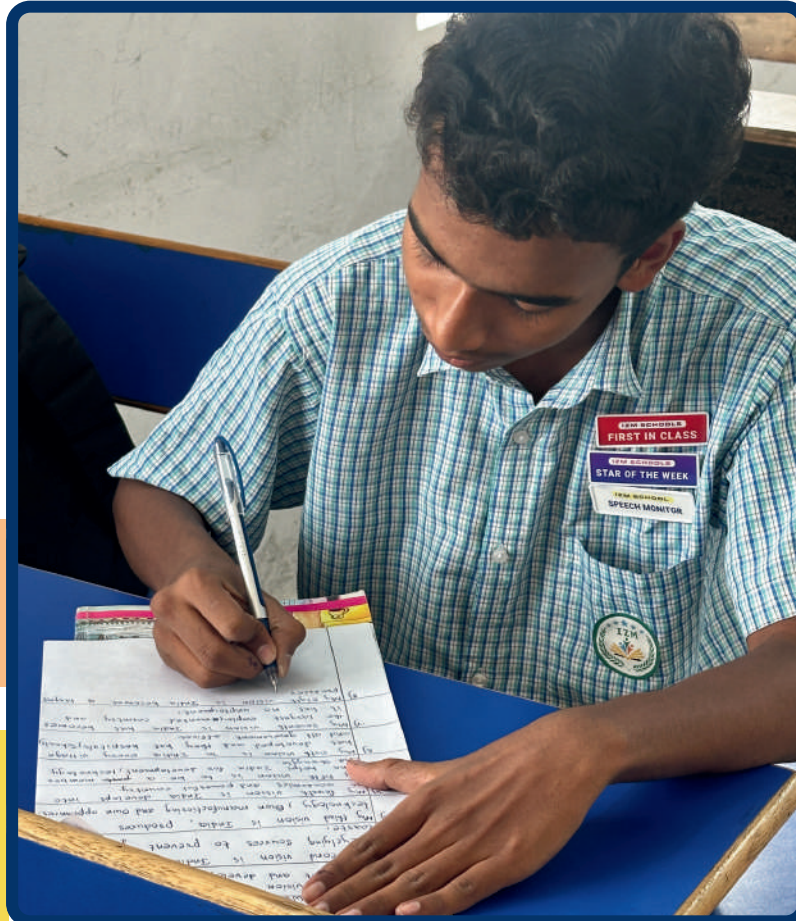




GLASS PAINTING ACTIVITY

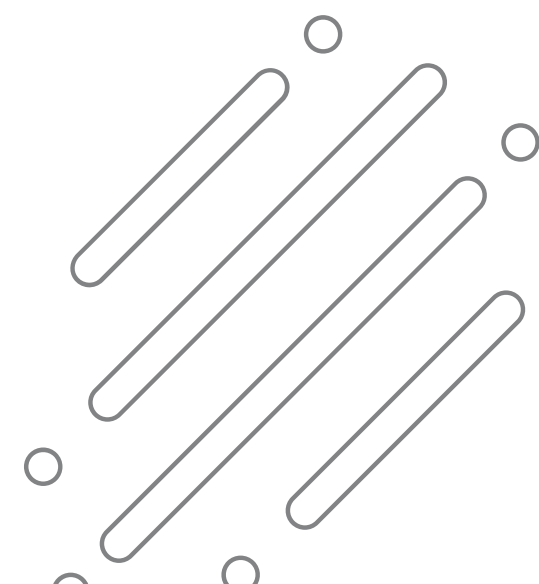
